GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION

The distance from Lutsk to Kyiv, the capital of Ukraine, is 400 km. Motor road distances to important European economic centres: Warsaw – 395 km; Vilnius – 720 km; Budapest – 730 km; Bucharest – 870 km; Bratislava – 920 km; Vienna – 930 km; Berlin – 970 km; Prague – 1000 km; Sofia – 1250 km. **Distances to major seaports:** Gdansk – 730 km; Odesa – 800 km; Hamburg – 1250 km; Rotterdam – 1600 km.



TRANSPORT INFRASTRUCTURE




The network of public motorways of state and local importance covers the total length of 6,195.3 kilometres, including 1,795.7 kilometres of state importance roads and 4,399.6 of local importance roads.

The motor roads M-07, M-19, H-22 go through the territory of the region.



The total length of railways is 631.3 km. There are 6 railway lines in the region. The main railway junctions are Kovel, Kivertsi and Lutsk. In the region, there are 65 km of Western-European track (1435 mm) with the connection Yagodyn-Kovel.

There is also a metallurgical broad-gauge line (LHS) with a length of 394 km, which passes through the Izów-Ustylug stations and goes deep into Poland to the Upper Silesia coal basin.









AVERAGE MONTHLY SALARY ACCORDING TO TYPES OF ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

Special attention in the region is paid to the development of the professional education system, because high-quality training of workers is the key to the development of the state. Therefore, active work is underway in the region to create a high-quality, flexible and practical system of professional education. Vocational and technical education is actively developing in the region and at a high level.


There are **20 vocational** and technical education institutions. The contingent of professional (vocational and technical) education institutions of the region is more than **8,000 people**.



The mineral and raw material base of the region has a significant potential, capable of ensuring the further development of industry in market conditions and is characterized by the presence in the subsoil of **18** types of minerals, among which **12 (coal, natural gas, peat, germanium, glass sand, underground fresh and mineral waters, peat mud, cement raw materials, copper and phosphorites).**

ECONOMIC Potential



MACHINE INDUSTRY

The main production facilities of the machine-building industry are located mainly in Lutsk.

The machine-building industry is one of the most important branches of the manufacturing industry. About **8,000 people** are employed in these enterprises in the Volyn region.

Private joint-stock company SKF Ukraine, which is part of the SKF corporation, is the only manufacturer of tapered roller bearings and their components in Ukraine. The company is a powerful supplier of bearings for the conveyor plants of the leading manufacturers of automotive equipment in Europe, America and Asia, as well as a reliable supplier of components (rings after turning and rollers) for the plants of the SKF corporation. **The Kromberg & Schubert**, the company employs more than 5,000 people. The plant in Lutsk manufactures electric cable networks for cargo and passenger minibuses, cars, networks for instrument panels, doors, roofs, motors, seats, as well as networks for motorcycles. The largest customers of the plant are car manufacturers BMW, Volkswagen and Mercedes-Benz.

There is also the Lutsk Automobile Plant Bohdan, which produces Bohdan buses, trolleybuses and electric buses, and the Lutsk Repair Plant Motor - a state-owned enterprise of the aviation industry of Ukraine, located in Lutsk. The enterprise carries out diagnostics, repair, maintenance of turbojet aircraft engines of the third and fourth generation.

It is the only enterprise in Ukraine capable of repairing RD-33 aircraft engines and is included in the list of enterprises of strategic importance for the economy and security of Ukraine.



WOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRY

The main products of the woodworking industry are: chipboard and fiberboard, lumber, wooden containers, carpentry, glued boards, parquet, veneer, paper bags, envelopes, etc.

On our territory is situated the **Kronospan UA Enterprise**, which is one of the largest producers of wood-based panel materials in Ukraine - laminated and polished chipboard, boards and post-forming. In addition, the company sells other products of the Kronospan Group, namely: MDF board, sanded and varnished HDF, glossy HDD boards, OSB board, laminated flooring, wall panels, window sills, accessories, etc.





Chemical industry enterprises produce plastic products, fine chemical products, household chemicals, etc.

Terihem Tervakoski is engaged in the production of capacitor film, 100% of their products are exported. The film produced by the enterprise is a component of capacitors - passive electrical equipment that can perform various tasks in circuits due to the ability to collect charge and energy of an electric field.

Tatrafan works in the direction of manufacturing packaging film. All candies, which are packed in polypropylene film, such brands as "Roshen", "Svitoch", "Korona", are all wrapped in Tatrafan film. They sell packaging film (for the production of packaging) only in Ukraine, and heat-shrinkable (tobacco) film in Ukraine, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Moldova.

In addition, the structure of **Tatrafan** includes another small Lutsk company **Hemosvit-Lutskhim** for the production of packaging, which is a subsidiary of the Slovak company **Hemosvit**, the owners of which, in turn, are shareholders of **Tatrafan**.



LIGHT INDUSTRY

Enterprises of the industry produce carpet (tufted) coverings, textile and fur clothing, overalls, bed linen, leather, awnings for cars.

Edelvika PJSC and the Edelvika brand were founded in 1994 in the city of Lutsk. The enterprise is located on 6400 m² and has about 250 employees (textile production).

The agricultural sector ensures food security of the region and food independence of the country.

The region occupies **2014.4 thousand hectares - 3.3% of the territory of Ukraine**, including agricultural land - **1047.5 thousand ha**, arable land - **672.3 thousand ha** and produces almost 3% of the national volume of agricultural products.

Volyn has a powerful agro-industrial complex, the basis of which is 944 agricultural enterprises, including **567 farms and 158.2 thousand personal peasant farms.**

About 20% of the region's gross added value is created in agriculture.

The largest agricultural enterprises in the region are: the **Volyn-Zerno-Produkt** company, today it is a group of companies under the VILIA trademark, which cultivates about 19 thousand hectares of land in the Volyn and Rivne regions, elevators, flour milling complexes, and its own grain processing line, seed plant and much more.

Agro-industrial group **Pan Kurchak** unites enterprises of a complete closed cycle: from the cultivation of grain and production of fodder for own poultry farms and pig farms, to the production and sale of finished products and meat products.





SMALL AND MEDIUM-SIZED ENTERPRISES

Small and medium-sized enterprises are developing in almost all sectors of the region's economy and are characterized by sustainable development.

At the beginning of 2019, there were 5,917 enterprises operating in the territory of the Volyn region, including: 5,591 small enterprises (of which 4,729 are microenterprises), 314 medium and 12 large enterprises.

There is a positive trend towards an increase in the number of small enterprises. Compared to the previous period, their number increased by 5.6 percent (228 enterprises). At the same time, the number of medium-sized enterprises decreased by 6.8 percent (20 enterprises). In the region, the number of small enterprises per 10,000 people of the existing population

is **54 units**, which is 3 units more than in previous years.

The region has a well-developed infrastructure to support small and medium-sized enterprises, public organizations of business entities and 43 administrative service centers. The development of business is facilitated by the introduction of various innovative technologies: eservices at administrative service centers, the electronic reporting system in the bodies of state statistics, and state tax service.

The tourist potential of the Volyn region is formed by: 2 tourist information centers, 3 national parks, 231 recreational areas, 118 recreational points, 267 lakes, 285 agricultural estates, 152 accommodation facilities, 7 sanatoriums, 17 museum facilities, 1534 objects of cultural heritage, 11 festivals (more than 1,000 tourists), 1 tourist cluster, 8 marked tourist routes, 7 tourist signs, 5 active tourist clubs, 2 eco-parks, 2 official tourist web resources, 341 subjects of tourist activity in the region.

The main directions of development of the tourism industry in the region are:

- 1. Personnel and scientific and methodological support.
- 2. Development of tourist infrastructure and material and technical base.
- 3. Stimulation of the development of sanatorium-resort tourism.
- 4. Rural tourism.
- 5. Promotion of tourist and recreational potential.
- 6. Safety of tourists.

The main tasks in the field of culture of the region are to ensure the realization of citizens' rights to access to information, to acquire artistic education, to be involved in cultural values and spiritual heritage, to create conditions for the operation of the basic network of cultural institutions at the local level, and to provide quality cultural services for all segments of the population.

There is an extensive basic network of cultural and art institutions in the Volyn **region.** These are, in particular:

- 675 club facilities (Palaces of Culture, Prosvita folk houses, cultural and artistic centers, clubs and houses of culture);

- **550** library institutions;

- 37 art schools (27 music, 3 artistic, 7 art schools) and 11 of their rural branches. In addition, there are 61 rural classes for learning to play various instruments. The number of pupils is 6,816 children;

– 17 communal museums and 84 public museum institutions, including 6 folk. Library of Volyn is represented by 550 institutions, of which 471 are libraries, operating in rural areas.



FOREIGN TRADE

EXPORT

In 2022, exports of goods amounted to 1,066.6 million US dollars, or 128.1% compared to 2021, imports - 2,032.3 million dollars, or 112.0%.





Leading partner countries of Volyn region in terms of **import** volumes






FOREIGN INVESTMENTS



Volyn region has taken a leading position in the investment attractiveness rating of Ukrainian regions over recent years. The region in Ukraine according to the amount of foreign investment per resident.



Investments in the region came from **32** countries. The main investor countries of the region's economy, which amounted to 92.1% of the total volume of direct foreign investments, included: Cyprus, Poland, Sweden, Slovakia, Austria, Germany. The largest investment was from Cyprus - **135.5** million dollars and Poland - **36.0** million dollars.



Foreign direct investments by economic activities:




Major enterprises with foreign investments:

BRV-Ukraine is another production site of the Black Red White group of companies from Poland, engaged in the production of cabinet furniture in the city of Novovolynsk; manufacturer of garbage bags, gloves, cling film and foil, napkins, sponges, disposable tableware **Stella pack** in Lutsk; manufacturer of electrical on-board cable systems for world-class cars Mercedes, Volkswagen, BMW, Audi Kromberg & Schubert Ukraine Lu, Lutsk; manufacturer of low-power transformers HahnElektrobauGmbH, Novovolynsk; manufacturer of condenser film Terihem Tervakoski; production of packaging film Tatrafan in Lutsk; European manufacturer of sheet materials based on wood Kronospan UA in Novovolynsk; production of cold sauces, namely mayonnaise, ketchup, mustard, sauces under the trademark Torchyn and a factory for the production of food products PJSC Volynholding Torchyn; production of roller, conical and cardan bearings, as well as bearing components SKF Ukraine in Lutsk and many other facilities.
